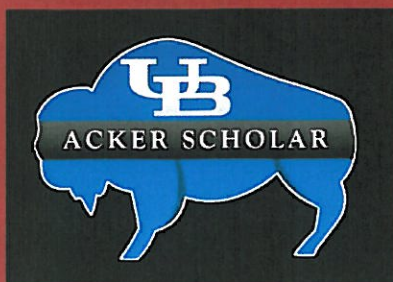

- Internship or practicum
- Study abroad
- Undergraduate supervised teaching (TA)
- Graduate coursework
- Departmental Honors coursework, thesis or project
- UB Leadership Certificate
- Becoming a Diversity Advocate/Wellness Peer Educator/Tutor
- Becoming a RA/AA/CA/OA

**Students must also complete:**

**20 hrs of community Service during Freshman Year, and  
10 hrs of community service during their Sophomore year**

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
