

## 2017 Presentation Information

All abstracts for Oral and Poster presentations are by COB on July 12, 2017

Abstracts should be submitted to <http://vovici.com/wsb.dll/s/8727g59f60>

Abstracts should be 100 words or less and will be published in the proceedings book. This 100 word limit does not include the presentation title, student name, faculty mentor name, and 1-2 references if needed.

Poster presentations will take place at 4:30 pm on Thursday July 27<sup>th</sup>. Presenting students will be permitted to begin setting up at 4:00 pm. Poster stands and mounting boards are provided. Finally, we recommend that posters do not exceed 36”h x 48”w in size.

Oral presentations will be presented throughout the day on Friday July 28<sup>th</sup> and Saturday July 29<sup>th</sup>. Oral presentations are given a 20 minute timeslot where it is expected that the student will present for 15 minutes followed by a 5 minute question and answer session. All presenters will have a staff moderator present to facilitate their session.

Technology for oral presentations is provided. This includes a Windows laptop, projector, and speakers (if requested). We ask that students not remove our computers to substitute their own. Furthermore, while there is internet available at the conference center it is not a perfect connection and so we strongly recommend that students come prepared with their presentation in a format where they will NOT require internet – a USB flash drive has proven to be the preferred method. If there is a need for a special accommodation, please contact the McNair program staff prior to arriving at the conference.

Finally, typically we do not take requests for oral presentation timeslots. However, if a student has a religious or traveling commitment that would not permit them to present at certain time or day, program staff should contact our office prior to July 7<sup>th</sup> as we do understand these situations. Requests made after this date cannot be guaranteed.
